Kozmo Gastro Pub opens in Alpharetta

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North Fulton residents will have a new restaurant to enjoy American food favorites like hamburgers, fried chicken and macaroni and cheese thanks to restaurateur Oswald Morgan.

Kozmo Gastro Pub, Morgan's 3,000-square-foot new restaurant, will open in late January in Johns Creek.

"I am so excited to bring the gastro pub concept to this area," Morgan said.

"Johns Creek has really started evolving in the past couple of years, and I think Kozmo will fit in perfect with the area's transition."

The restaurant's food menu will feature items that do not exceed \$14 while the drink menu will focus on the "Kozmo."

The restaurant will have an extensive cocktail list that as Morgan says "gives the Cosmopolitan drink new life."

There will be a new "Kozmo" of the day along with a "Kozmo-Rita," "Kozmojito," and other popular drinks that range from \$5 to \$8.

"I wanted to bring a new, hip place to the people of the Alpharetta community, instead of them having to drive to Atlanta," Morgan said.

"Now they can experience what they would in the city, in their own backyards."

Morgan, who was a partner with the Globe restaurant in Atlanta, has been working on the Kozmo Gastro Pub for a little over a year and a

half and said that creating an environment like this is something he has always wanted to do.

"I wanted to start a place

up that was affordable, fun, and a place that had a good bar crowd as well as a place where families would be proud to go to and I think I

have accomplished that.”

Morgan said he cannot wait to see the community’s reaction to the restaurant.

“I’m very excited about the whole thing, but at the same time a little nervous,” Morgan said.

“I think it is the right concept for the times. I really want it to be a neighborhood place, where people can go to eat good food or to unwind after a long day.

“I definitely believe this is going to be a place that the community is going to enjoy,” he added.

Kozmo Gastro Pub is located at the corner of Douglas and Jones’ Bridge and once it officially opens, it will be open daily at 4:30 p.m., serving dinner seven nights a week.

The restaurant will also be serving brunch on Saturdays and Sundays.
